Il Colle del Corsicano - Licosa 2022 Cilento DOC Fiano

(organic) The nose is aromatic and offers a certain complexity and energy. It expresses notes of crunchy flat peach, dried apple and small notes ofvarietal notes, combined with touches of easy zest, juicy/ ripe kumquat, as well as hints of lemon blossom and a very discreet saline touch. There are also fine notes of elderflower that appear. The mouth is nicely led, delicate, and offers a certain purity, a nice roundness and suavity, accompanied by a nice acidity/juiciness of the fruit and saline/iodized notes. It expresses notes of juicy/pulpy lemon, bright quenette, and small notes of acidulated vine peach, associated with touches of zest, pretty saline note, as well as hints of sense of place/ warm sap and fine hints of tangy/bright exotic fruits, as well as a fine mineral hint. Good length and definition, and a nice sapid persistence.

Il Colle del Corsicano – Licosa 2020 Cilento DOC Fiano

(organic) The nose is aromatic, elegant, and offers a beautiful definition and a certain complexity. It expresses notes of ripe/fresh almond, fresh/pulpy pear and small notes of kumquat, associated with fine touches of ripe quince as well as slight hints of a sense of place (local biotop) / fresh grove, a fine hint of fresh flowers, almost vegetal and slight hints of salinity. The palate is fruity and offers acidity, a beautiful energy, a mineral structure, tension, precision, a nice small fat, suavity as well as a beautiful aerial side in its matter and in the fleshiness of its fruit. It expresses notes of fleshy/juicy apple, luscious/juicy peach, and small notes of quince associated with touches of juicy/ripe pineapple, fine hints of small exotic fruits, as well as fine hints of toasted almond. Almost a discreet tannic hint in the aromatic and in the structure. A small iodized/saline side in the background. Beautiful acidity. Score: 16/20 (92/100)

PAESTUM IGP

Il Colle del Corsicano - Furano 2022 IGP Paestum Rosato

(organic) A nice aromatic, intense nose, which offers straightness, and expresses notes of quite ripe fresh cherry, English candy and small notes of violet, associated with touches almost of orange blossom, candied zest, fine hints of jammy strawberry and a hint of flowers. The mouth is fruity and offers freshness, minerality, a nice definition, a spherical side in its definition, freshness, energy, as well as some stretchiness/ aerial side. It expresses notes of luscious/juicy cherry, crushed redcurrants (almost sweet) and more slightly - English candy, associated with touches of luscious peach, candied kumquat, as well as fine varietal/floral hints. Nice freshness and sapidity in the background. Almost a discrete pearly/ rocky touch (granitic) in the background.

Il Colle del Corsicano -Patrinus 2021 Paestum Rosso IGP

(Organic - agliaico 95%)A nice fruity nose, which offers a certain controlled power, depth, a certain intensity and a nice slight spiciness. It expresses the notes of boysenberry, dense dark berries and small notes of camphor, combined with touches of bigarreau cherry, concentrated blueberry and small notes of plum blossom, quite ripe/bright plum, hints of sense of

place/warm olive tree, as well as hints of pepper, fresh anise and a hint of spice. The mouth is silky, supple, gourmand, finely tight and offers a certain elegance, energy, juiciness, a certain depth, a nice stretchiness. It expresses notes of juicy/pulpy blackberry, juicy/pulpy black plum, and more lightly - small crushed black berries, associated with touches of bigarreau cherry, violet, lily, as well as fine almost eucalyptus hints. in the background, a sense of place, toast, tonka bean, as well as a hint of minerality, almost oceanic, and delicate hints of anise and chocolate. The tannins are supple, ripe and suave. A very nice persistence.

Il Colle del Corsicano -Patrinus 2021 Paestum Rosso IGP

The nose is fruity, spicy, a bit reduced. It expresses a nice ripeness, notes of fairly ripe wild strawberry, fairly ripe blackcurrant and small notes of dried cherry, combined with touches of cardamom, black olive, local dry subsoil, almost a very discreet hint of rosemary, as well as fine hints of anise and cubeb pepper. The palate is fruity and offers juiciness, a tangy frame, minerality, good definition, gourmandise, tension, precision, aerial side, depth, a certain density, and great ripeness. It



expresses the notes of luscious/juicy cherry, crushed raspberry and more lightly - quite ripe small black berries, combined with hints of quite ripe black plum, fig, black olive, chocolate, as well as nice hints of racy minerality, chocolate, a slight hint of warm olive, as well as hints of dry ground/local warm earth. The tannins are soft, gourmand and sapid. Purity and a nice definition in the mouth.

San Salvatore 1988 - Cecerale 2022 Paestum Fiano IGP

The nose is fruity and offers complexity, a certain richness of the terroir and depth. It expresses the notes of nectarine, white flowers and small notes of passion fruit combined with touches of peach blossom, fresh local grove. The palate is fruity, very discreetly tight and offers minerality, juiciness, a tangy structure and a good definition. It expresses notes of fresh peach, zest and small notes of peach blossom associated with small touches of local grove, as well as a subtle hint of fresh olive and fine almost orange and mesocarpic tips. A subtle, almost tannic hint at the end of the palate. A very discreet hint of good bitterness.

San Salvatore 1988 - Pian di Stio 2022

Paestum Fiano IGP

(Organic) A pretty suave, elegant, round, gourmand nose, which offers aerial side and a pretty purity. It expresses notes of bright nectarine, quenette and small notes of bright nectarine, associated with a touch of bright apricot. The palate is fruity and offers juiciness, suavity, a nice definition, a tangy frame, tension, precision, elegance, roundness, precision, gourmandise. It expresses the notes of pulpy/juicy apple, bright quenette and small notes of bright vine peach, associated with a touch of acidulous/pulpy apricot as well as hints of passion fruit. A very discreet almost tannic hint and an imperceptible hint of butter on the background. Nice freshness and tanginess, a subtle hint almost varietal, saline and with a sense of place in the background. Good definition and persistence.

San Salvatore 1988 - Pian di Stio 2018

Paestum Fiano IGP

(organic) The nose has a nice grain and expresses notes of dry oak, blond tobacco and small notes of bright nectarine, associated with small touches almost of aromatic herbs, small fresh yellow fruits, crunchy mirabelle plum, as well as fine hints almost of fresh cloves and a hint of ripe pineapple. The palate is mineral and offers some freshness, tension and precision, a certain straightness, a good structure and a nice acidity. It expresses the notes of pulpy peach, slightly toasted oak, dried nectarine and small notes of pulpy peach, small fresh yellow berries, associated with a touch of sense of place, fresh fennel, with a very discreet iodized hint in the background, dry pineapple as well as discreet hints of fresh yellow flowers. The mouth also gives a feeling of soft tannins. An evolved, gourmet white wine that offers fatness, richness, lovely juiciness, delicate roundness and fullness with a sublime hint of nutmeg in the background.

San Salvatore 1988 – Pian di Stio, Evoluzione 2019 Paestum IGP

The nose is fruity, fresh, aromatic and offers a certain intensity, a certain complexity. It expresses notes of quince, small fresh/juicy yellow fruits and more slightly - wild fennel, combined with touches of nectarine and a discreet hint of fresh almond. The mouth is fruity and offers juiciness, freshness, minerality, a nice definition, a mineral frame, tension, precision. It expresses notes of juicy/pulpy apple, juicy/pulpy yellow peach and more slightly - quince, combined with touches of fresh mirabelle plum, fennel/wild sage, as well as slight hints of fresh sweet spices and fresh almond. Good length, nice crunchy acidity in the background. A nice minerality and freshness. Score: 16/20 (92/100)

San Salvatore 1988 – Pino di Stio 2020

Paestum IGP

A nice fruity nose, which offers intensity, a nice definition, and some concentration. It expresses notes of black plum, violet and small notes of small crushed blue fruits, associated with touches of fairly ripe blackcurrant, fine hints of fairly ripe wild strawberry, a hint of roasted fruit, as well as delicate hints of local garrigue (wild fennel, sage, rosemary...), as well as a discreet hint of pepper. The palate is fruity and offers juiciness, suavity, gourmandise, elegance, a nice definition, a tangy frame, a very beautiful purity, precision, delicacy and aerial side. It expresses the

notes of pulpy/juicy purple plum, violet, bright cassis and small notes of roasted cherry, associated with touches of lily, small roasted red berries, as well as fine hints of a sense of place, salinity and a hint of good bitterness and chocolate in the background. the tannins are polished and elegant. A nice finesse, freshness and delicacy in its fattiness. A very nice mouthfeel.

San Salvatore – Omaggio a Gillo Dorfles 2017 Paestum IGP

The nose is elegant, precisely led and offers power and intensity with precision and depth, controlled power, complexity and a nice definition of its grain. It expresses notes of violet, purple plum and slight notes of cherry, associated with delicate touches of small wild black berries, and juniper berries as well as hints of black pepper, and dry garrigue. The mouth is juicy, fruity and offers elegance, power, concentration, density, and a nice purity in its straightness, tension, freshness, a nice precise structure. It expresses notes of juicy/pulpy blackberry, dry blackcurrant and small notes of dry garrigue (anise, rosemary, olive tree), as well as hints of black olive, cocoa/mocha, as well as hints of racv minerality, roasted cherry, fine hints of small, dense black juniper berries. The tannins are supple, precise and elegant. A pretty delicate substance, gourmand, precise, a nice persistence, beautiful freshness and minerality. A saline point in the background.

San Salvatore 1988 - Vetere 2022 Paestum Rosato IGP

Score: 17.5/20 (95/100)

The nose is fruity, fresh and expresses notes of raspberry, lychee and more lightly — bright peach, associated with a subtle floral hint and an imperceptible hint almost lime and an imperceptible hint of apricot. The palate is mineral and offers freshness, tension, precision, and a tangy frame. It expresses notes of bright vine peach, tangerine and small notes of lychee, combined with a floral touch and a subtle hint of almost zest in the background.

Score: 15.25/20 (90/100)

San Salvatore – 2021 Vetere Evoluzione Paestum Rosato IGP

The nose is aromatic and expresses notes of lychee, ripe lemon and - slightly toasted/oaked, associated with slight touches of juicy mandarin as well as fine hints of bright berries. The palate is mineral and offers precision, some tension, a tense/stretched grain as well as fine sensation of tannins. It expresses notes of juicy/fresh nectarine, minerality and small notes of apricot associated with touches of toasted oak and a subtle almost tangerine hint and dried almond. A gourmet rosé, with structure and suavity.

San Salvatore 1988 – Palinure 2022 Paestum IGP

The nose is fruity, gourmand and expresses the notes of quenette, bright vine peach, associated with slight hints of bright berries, as well as slight hints of verbena and discreet hints almost sense of place and ocean. The mouth is fruity and offers juiciness, minerality, some freshness, roundness, some fattiness, and a tangy frame. It expresses notes of pulpy peach, crushed nectarine, and small notes of lychees, associated with a touch of mandarin, as well as a hint of mesocarp and a very discreet hint almost sweet/fresh grapefruit. Good length, mentality and a certain freshness. Nice tangy citrus in the background.

Score: 15.25/20 (90/100)

San Salvatore 1988 - Trentenare 2022 Paestum Fiano IGP

The nose is fresh, precise and offers purity and some minerality. It expresses notes of crunchy peach, apple and small notes of almost fresh pear, combined with touches of lychee, passion fruit and a very discreet hint of quenette and tangerine. The palate is fruity and offers juiciness, a tangy frame, minerality, a nice suavity and a nice freshness. It expresses notes of quenette, white flowers, associated with touches of fresh mandarin, as well as a subtle hint of apricot blossoms and hints of juicy/fresh citrus fruits.

Score: 15.5/20 (90-91/100)

San Salvatore 1988 – Calpazio 2022 Paestum Greco IGP

The nose is fruity and offers some pulpiness and delicacy. It expresses notes of crunchy peach, quenette and small notes of verbena, associated with a touch of fresh almond, and a subtle hint of sage. The palate is fruity and offers juiciness, suavity, an acid frame, good definition, precision. It expresses notes of tangerine, quince and small notes of tangy apricot, combined with touches of crunchy peach and a hint of verbena and sage. Score: 15.25/20 (90/100)



San Salvatore 1988 – Corleto 2022 Paestum IGP

(without sulphites) The nose is fruity, elegant and offers fleshiness and delicacy, as well as some power in the background. It expresses the notes of crushed cherry, liquorice and small notes of dense purple plum, combined with touches of crushed strawberry, as well as fine hints of black olive, a hint of flowers and a discreet oceanic touche. The palate is fruity and offers juiciness, suavity, a tangy frame, minerality, good definition, a certain tension, precision, precision, finesse of the structure and a fine straightness. It expresses the notes of pulpy/bright cherry, crushed plum and small notes of local grove associated with hints of liquorice, as well as a hint of strawberry and fine hints of sense of place, rosemary and a subtle good bitterness in the background. A nice persistence, supple tannins, a subtle almost milky hint on the persistence.

San Salvatore 1988 – Ceraso 2022 Paestum IGP

The nose is fruity and offers a discreetly tight minerality. It expresses notes of blackberry, luscious cherry and small notes of fresh pulpy purple plum associated with touches of small crushed red berries as well as hints of comflower and star anise. The palate is fruity and offers minerality, a certain precision, a tangy structure, energy, some aerial side in its richness/power and a good tannic

structure. It expresses the notes of pulpy/juicy cherry, pulpy/juicy plum and small notes of small wild red berries associated with touches of rosemary, thyme, local grove, with a subtle hint of liquorice and a subtle hint of black olive/almost tapenade. The tannins are supple. Good length, minerality, suppleness and silkiness.

San Salvatore 1988 – Jungano 2020 Paestum IGP

The nose is fruity, racy and finely powerful and offers a certain power, a precise grain. It expresses notes of violet, bright purple plum, combined with touches of quite ripe blueberry, as well as hints of sage, almost minty and a very discreet hint almost green pepper. The mouth is nicely supple and offers roundness, fat, a tangy structure, energy, purity, and a nice definition, a nice tannic structure. It expresses notes of violet plum, small bright red berries and small notes of violet associated with touches of blueberry, as well as a hint of cherry blossom, sage, rosemary and a subtle hint almost blond tobacco. Suppleness, polished tannins. Good definition ${\bf Score}: 15.5+/20~(91/100)$

San Salvatore 1988 – Omaggio a Gillo Dorfles 2017 Paestum IGP

The nose is elegant aromatic, and offers brightness and complexity. It expresses notes of blackberry, bright plum and small notes of balsamic associated with touches of fresh sap, liquorice stick and a hint of wild strawberry and tobacco. The palate is fruity and offers minerality, a juicy frame, elegance, and bitterness. It expresses notes of fleshy plum, fleshy blackberry and small notes of crushed strawberry associated with touches of balsamic, truffle as well as hints of nutmeg, and a subtle hint of toasted hazelnut, black olive and evolution. The nose also expresses a hint of truffle. Flexibility, elegance, creaminess in purity and balance. Score: 16.25/20 (92-93/100)

BENEVENTANO IGP

Fontana Reale - Merlonero 2021 Beneventano Merlot IGP

The nose is fruity and offers a slight power, a precise and frank grain, fullness. It expresses the notes of pulpy cherry, bright raspberry and, more slightly, prickly pear associated with touches of spice, sense of place and almost a discreet hint of citrus. The palate is fruity and offers juiciness, minerality, a tangy structure, energy, good definition, tension, and a discreetly tight tannic structure. It expresses the notes of prickly pear, rhubarb and, more slightly, bright/tangy plum associated with a touch of sense of the place of iodine and a discreet hint almost sage in the background. Good length. The tannins are racy, mellow.

Tenuta Sant'Agostino - Attoprimo 2020 Beneventano Rosso IGP

The nose offers a certain concentration, a certain richness, almost a fine creaminess on the nose, gournandise. It expresses notes of creamy blackberry, luscious wild blackcurrant and more lightly – rhubarb associated with touches of violet, liquorice stick as well as creamy, toasted and chocolate hints. The mouth is mineral and offers some fattiness, suavity, some creaminess in minerality, gourmandise. It expresses notes of creamy blackcurrant, bright raspberry and, more slightly, rhubarb associated with touches of balsamic, chocolate and fine hints of liquorice stick. The tannins are relatively polished. A fine hint of coffee and bourbon vanilla in the background. Needs time to digest the wood. Score: 15.5/20 (90-91/100)

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CAMPANIA IGP

Abbazia di Crapolla – Sireo 2020 Campania IGP

The nose offers a nice freshness as well as a certain brightness. It reveals notes of fresh mirabelle plum, fresh/ripe kumquat and small notes of yellow berries associated with discreet hints of butter and a very discreet hint of sage/verbena. The palate is fruity, wellbalanced and offers a beautiful juiciness, roundness, freshness, sapidity, a certain purity, an acidulous structure, minerality, a certain gourmandise, a good definition, a small fat as well as fine concentration. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of quince, tangerine and small notes of pulpy/juicy mirabelle plum associated with touches of acidulous apricot, slight hints of exotic fruits as well as slight hints of peach blossom, verbena and a fine hint of butter (in the

background). Good length. Score: 15.75+/20 (91-92/100)

Abbazia di Crapolla – Sireo 2018 Campania IGP

The nose is fruity and offers a very fine concentration of fruit. It reveals notes of mirabelle plum, sage and small notes of crushed small yellow fruits associated with touches of mango, fine hints of aromatic herbs as well as discreet hints of dried straw (in the background) and a very discreet hint of clove. The palate is fruity and offers juiciness, an acid frame, minerality, a good definition, sapidity as well as a good job on the good bitters. On the palate, this wine expresses buttery notes, crushed mirabelle plum and small notes of mango associated with fine touches of crushed exotic fruits, slight hints of nutmeg, chestnut and a subtle hint of good bitterness. Good length.

Cantina del Barone - Particella 928 2020

Campania Fiano IGP

A nice fruity and aromatic nose with a controlled oxidative note. The palate is fruity, enveloping, velvety and offers juiciness, a tangy frame, a nice freshness, and gourmandise. It expresses the notes of juicy kumquat, crushed physalis and small notes of small yellow fruits, associated with a buttery touch, as well as hints of white flowers/lily and a discreet hint of a sense of place/fresh. A fine oaky and toasted notes in the background.

San Salvatore 1988 - Falanghina 2022 Campania IGP

The nose is fruity and offers a certain elegance, some depth and a certain intensity. It expresses notes of tangerine, zest and small notes of exotic fruits. The palate is fruity, tangy and offers juiciness, a certain brightness, and nice floral notes and gourmandise. It expresses notes of white flowers/lily of the valley, peach blossoms and small notes of citrus fruits (tangerine, bright lemon), associated with touches almost liquorice/acacia. Nice definition. Good length. Pretty notes of lychee and white flowers.

Score: 15+/20 (89-90/100)

Pietracupa - Quirico 2019 Campania Aglianico IGP

The nose is precise, fresh and expresses notes of crushed raspberry, pulpy wild blackberry and, more slightly, violet, combined with touches of balsamic, pepper, cloves and subtle iodine/saline hints. The palate is fruity and offers minerality, precision, purity and a nice definition of the fruit. It expresses the notes of bright raspberry, pulpy/juicy cherry and, more slightly, cornflower, associated with touches of liquorice stick, balsamic as well as fine hints of cardamom, almost camphor and mocha. The tannins are elegant, supple and sapid. Good length, nice freshness. A fine eucalyptus note in the background. Score: 15.75/20 (91-92/100)

Galardi - Terra di Rosso 2020 Campania Piedirosso IGP

The nose is fruity and offers a fine concentration, a fine richness and a fine stretchiness. It expresses notes of roasted blackcurrant, morello cherry and small notes of jammy strawberry, combined with a touch of liquorice, spices and discreet/delicate floral hints. The palate is fruity, distinctly tight and offers minerality, a tangy frame, tension, a certain precision, substance and a certain richness, a good job on the good bitters. It expresses sunny, ripe fruits: notes of fairly ripe blackcurrant, roasted cherry and small notes. of roasted/crushed berries associated with touches of liquorice stick, racy minerality and fine hints of cornflower, vanilla and a hint of blond tobacco in the background. Good length and definition, fine hints of dark chocolate in the base. A fairly ripe wine, but which retains freshness, minerality and balance.

(Bianco) The nose is fruity, elegant, fresh, nicely aromatic. It expresses the notes of papaya/carambola, green apple and small notes of crisp green peach, combined with touches of white flowers, fresh local biotope as well as hints of lemon blossom and a very discreet touch almost yuzu. The palate is fruity and offers juiciness, acidity, gourmandise, a tangy frame, energy, and purity. We feel all the sincerity and generosity of the place and the people. It expresses notes of tangy green peach, crunchy tangy apple and small notes of starfruit, combined with touches of lychee, citrus fruits (lemon, yuzu, fresh kumquat), as well as slight hints of zest and discreet hints of crushed exotic berries. Good length. Nice sapidity and suavity. Score: 16/20 (92/100)

Core 2020 Campania IGT

(Rosso) A nice mineral nose, fruit and a certain freshness, discreetly tight. It expresses the notes of pulpy/juicy red cherry, pulpy purple plum and small notes of pulpy/bright red berries, combined with hints of plum blossom, juniper berry, as well as hints of cherry as well as fine hints of fresh liquorice and an imperceptible hint of sage. A very discreet hint almost incense after aeration. The mouth is juicy, finely tight,

fresh, balanced, nice mineral frame, precision, nice energy, nice freshness. It expresses notes of juicy/fresh cherry, fresh blackberry and small notes of crunchy berries, fresh violet, as well as hints of fresh sage and discreet hints of almost fresh olive tree. The tannins are fresh, smooth and almost sappy. Nice freshness and a certain purity in its fruit and its freshness.

(Rosso) A nice fruity nose, which offers a nice fleshy/ pulpy fruit, a certain complexity, density and power. It expresses notes of luscious purple plum, bigarreau cherry and small notes of cornflower, combined with small touches of juniper berries, as well as hints of cherry blossom, star anise, and a discreet hint almost of vanilla flowers and sweet pepper. The mouth is fruity, fresh, elegant, racy and offers a nice definition, a tangy frame, minerality, tension, nice energy, nice freshness and minerality, as well as fine aerial side. It expresses notes of bright bigarreau cherry, small fresh/bright red berries and small notes of juicy blackcurrant, associated with a touch of violet, lily, sage as well as delicate hints of fresh plum and discreet hints of camphor, liquorice stick and a subtle hint almost chocolate very discreet in the background. The tannins are supple and finely mellow. Nice freshness and juiciness.

Montrevetrano 2020 Campania IGT

The nose is elegant, fresh, beautifully airy, and delicate. It expresses the notes of delicate violet, pulpy cherry and more lightly - bright raspberry, combined with delicate smoky hints, sense of place (warm biotope), as well as fine hints of blond tobacco, a discreet sappy hint with an imperceptible touch of pepper. The palate is nicely mineral, fresh, elegant, delicate and offers a nice rich substance/concentration, discreetly creamy, but full of energy and minerality, sincerity and generosity, nice multi-layered profile, and a fine graphic note in the background. The palate expresses notes of fresh/ pulpy raspberry, pulpy/juicy blackcurrant and small notes of cornflower, associated with touches of fresh red berries, a subtle almost roasted hint and fine hints of liquorice stick, as well as only to discreet saline hints, warm sap and a subtle hint almost smoky and chocolatey in the background. Beautiful delicacy and tension, the tannins are supple, sapid and creamy. A nice persistence, a certain density and a fine blackness. Score: 18/20 (96/100)

Montrevetrano 2009 Campania IGT

A nice elegant, velvety and rich nose, which offers depth, density, multilayers and a nice graphite notes of the grain. It expresses notes of dry blackberry, forest flor and small notes of fairly ripe small red fruits associated with touches of dry cherry, discreet/ delicate hints of purple plum as well as discreet hints of tobacco box, clove and almost a discreet hint of badiane in the background and delicate sweet spices. The palate is fruity, very discreetly tight and offers juiciness, minerality, a tangy structure, tension, precision, a nice aerial side in its substance and its controlled power with a certain subtlety. A beautiful affirmed identity! On the palate, this wine expresses notes of juicy/fresh cherries, juicy/ pulpy redcurrants and small notes of crushed red plums associated with touches of racy/volcanic minerality as well as hints of violet, fresh blond tobacco, a subtle hint of smoke and a sense of place (local biotop). The mouth is nicely fresh, well-balanced and offers a good definition, a tangy frame, a nice freshness as well as energy. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of juicy/fresh cherry, fresh/tangy red berries and small notes of fresh red plum associated with a touch of violet, blackcurrant, typical hints from volcanic rocks as well as a subtle almost fresh saffron hint (in the background) and fresh tobacco. The mouth is fresh, well-balanced, nicely racy and offers juiciness, suavity, energy, a nice dynamism, a polished side, a stretched side as well as verticality. On the palate, this wine expresses notes of tangy red cherry, small fresh/ crunchy red berries and small notes of racy minerality associated with touches of juniper berries, fine hints of a sense of place (local biotop), a discreet almost sage hint, licorice stick as well as a very discreet almost black olive hint and tonka bean (in the background). On the palate, this wine expresses notes of creamy blackberry, roasted cherry and small notes of roasted small fruits associated with touches of crushed blueberry, vanilla as well as hints of racy minerality, toast and a subtle hint of chocolate/toasted almond (in the background). A subtle almost sage hint in the background. Tannins are soft and elegant. Sapidity and a small softness on the finish/persistence.

The palate is fruity and offers minerality, a fresh frame, tension, precision, straightness. It expresses notes of pulpy blackberry, quite ripe purple plum and, more slightly, crushed raspberry, associated with touches of liquorice, chocolate as well as hints of toasted hazelnut and a discreet hint of coffee in the background. Good length. The tannins are silky and sapid.
